

## Player Guide to set up a MySquash account via welcome email January 2024

## Receiving the welcome email

- All players with an iSquash profile as a current club member will receive a MySquash welcome email, if their email address is correct in iSquash.
- Check your junk/spam folder if it doesn't show in your inbox after 31 January
- If you still haven't received the email, send your first name, last name, DOB and correct email address to <a href="mailto:support@squashnz.co.nz">support@squashnz.co.nz</a>. Squash NZ will update your account and resend you the welcome email.

## Setting up your account

• Open the email and click on 'Set up account'


As a current squash player in New Zealand, a MySquash account has been set up for you.

Please note that for the 2024 season, graded players will still require their iSquash profile to view and enter tournaments, and view interclub draws and results.


To get started, please set up your account by clicking on the link below:

• Click on 'Sign up with Email'




- Enter your email address that you received the welcome email from
- Click 'Continue




- Create a new password for your account and type it into the box
- Click 'Sign Up'




- Complete your details in all the fields
